I LOVE rugby and played semi-pro for the Minnesota Valkyrie for ten years. But then a knee injury took me off the team and started a downward spiral. I was severely depressed, began to abuse painkillers and marijuana, and lost my job and apartment. I kept my mental illness hidden for many years. I grew up in an orphanage in Sao Paulo, Brazil, where there was a lot of physical abuse. I was adopted at the age of ten and came to live here. But

the abuse had given me post-traumatic stress disorder and anger issues. Everything went downhill so fast.

Luckily I got into one of People Incorporated's programs, Maghakian Place, which specializes in helping people with mental illness and chemical addiction. I was nervous at first, but at the end of my 90 days I didn't want to leave! The staff are exceptional and so professional. They understand the mental illness underlying my addiction. I felt comfortable with every

INSTEAD, WE HELP THE PERSON **FOCUS** ON WHAT WENT WRONG AND DEVELOP STRATEGIES TO **PREVENT** IT FROM HAPPENING AGAIN.

staff person—and for me, that's saying a lot! Plus there's a schedule for the day, with group meetings, time for yourself, and outings such as bowling or going to the gym.

I had a few relapses at first, but they helped me keep on track. I felt safe to just let go and focus on dealing with my mental illness. I've been out now for a year, and live as a foster daughter with a local couple. I still come back to Maghakian to

take part in activities and their after-care program. I hope to go back to school, maybe work with kids in athletic programs, and I want to run a marathon. People Incorporated opened the door to all this for me—helped me to design a new future. It's so great to be looking forward again!

I SERVE others. That's what I do. I worked for many years as a pastor, including service as an interim pastor for congregations in transition, and then as a consultant for many start-up organizations, especially those helping people with mental illness and addiction. It has been a busy life—but I have also struggled for many years with severe depression and alcoholism. Now I am gratefully living in recovery and continuing

to learn important wellness skills that allow me to pay it forward. This is really a new and much more meaningful journey for me.

I was pretty excited when a friend told me about the certified peer support specialist training. Peer support is really at the cutting edge in helping people with mental illness—and gives me an official way to share my story with others who are struggling with similar issues. I now work in rotation at two

BACK WHEN PEOPLE WITH MENTAL ILLNESS WERE WAREHOUSED IN INSTITUTIONS, MUCH OF THEIR DIGNITY WAS STRIPPED AWAY. PEER SUPPORT SPECIALISTS HELP PEOPLE WITH MENTAL ILLNESS REGAIN THEIR SENSE OF SELF-DETERMINATION.

WE'RE CRAZY ABOUT THAT—AND ALWAYS HAVE BEEN.

People Incorporated crisis residences—Nancy Page and Diane Ahrens. My job is essentially to listen to clients—to develop a rapport and share my own story when it's appropriate. "Peers" avoid clinical language, giving clients the freedom to talk about their experiences from their own perspective. It helps to remove the stigma and makes the client the real "expert" in how they can live in recovery. It's incredibly empowering—I've seen its impact first-hand.

I am so impressed by People Incorporated and its staff—their talents and commitment. They are unique because they really focus on what each individual needs to recover and live in wellness, and will go the distance to see that it happens. Their business truly is people—they live up to their name.

I KNEW I needed to change. I was a drug dealer and user from New York. A friend told me to come to Minnesota to get away from all that. I'd already had a heart attack from the stress and drug use. I didn't want my kids to see me like that.

I was homeless at first, but my friend connected me with People Incorporated's Project Recovery—which helps people who are homeless, have mental

illness, and use drugs or alcohol. They helped me turn my life around 180 degrees. They made sure I saw a psychiatrist, got on the right medication, and started counseling sessions. I'm now studying for a degree in network engineering, and I just moved into my own apartment.

People Incorporated is so different from other organizations trying to help the homeless. For one thing, we don't just sit around all day. We have

OUR APPROACH HAS BEEN AMAZINGLY **SUCCESSFUL**, TOO—OF THE 159 PEOPLE WE PLACED IN APARTMENTS OVER THE PAST 30 MONTHS THROUGH OUR SAFE HAVENS PROGRAM, 151 (95%) HAVE REMAINED IN **INDEPENDENT** HOUSING.

meetings and group sessions, and learn to define our goals and work on them. The staff are fantastic—they really go way beyond the call of duty, and that goes right through to the top. One of the senior staff came out to meet with me and even helped me with an English paper for college. They really care. They treat you like an adult and help you take responsibility for your future. That is a huge difference.

I've been volunteering at Project Recovery since the first week. I do all sorts of things—from cleaning to showing others how to use the computer, or just talking with some of the guys here about getting help and moving on in a positive way. I think I'd like to do this kind of work long term. I would never have gotten to this place in my life without People Incorporated—I'm so grateful they are here.

DEAR FRIENDS,

Can we use words like crazy in our annual report? Insane? Wacko? Nuts? Yes. The point is that we, as a society, use those words casually in our everyday speech, yet we still clam up when it comes to talking about mental illness. We think that's crazy. Especially since there are so many effective ways to help people with mental illness today. We need to talk more about mental illness—but even more, we need to talk about solutions.

People Incorporated is all about providing solutions. We are dedicated to creating the innovative services and programs that help each person we serve find his or her own way to hope and healing. As you read in the stories in this report, we have wonderful

staff who truly care about the people they serve and will move mountains to help them succeed.

In 2009 we continued our record of success and stability, despite difficult economic times. We celebrated our 40th anniversary, served more than 6,570 people, opened three new programs/services, and secured ongoing state funding for our Safe Haven Services. You can read more 2009 highlights on the following pages. We also began work on our Park Avenue project, an innovative treatment center in Minneapolis for people with chemical dependency and mental illness. You'll be hearing more about this initiative in the coming months as we launch a campaign to raise the start-up funds we need. It's an

exciting project and one that will help so many people with chemical addiction and mental illness get the right kind of treatment.

How did we continue moving forward so strongly during the recession? Simply put, it is thanks to you. Whether it is through a donation, volunteer time, contacting your representatives, or even telling your friends about our work—our success comes down to you. Thank you for your service. Thank you for your gifts. And thank you for your ongoing commitment to bringing hope to people with mental illness. It is your belief in us that gives us our crazy enthusiasm to right the wrongs and fight the fight.

HIGHLIGHTS 2009

WE CELEBRATED our 40th anniversary at our Annual Luncheon on June 11 at the Metropolitan Ballroom with over 350 attendees, who heard a keynote speech by mental health advocate and author Kathy Cronkite; special guest U.S. Representative Jim Ramstad received an award for his work on behalf of people with mental illness.

WE RECORDED a 40th anniversary video with stories from our clients, founders, leaders, and community members.

WE CELEBRATED Artability's 15th anniversary, and sold 85 pieces of art from 58 artists for a total of \$8,100; over 450 people attended the three-day event.

WE OPENED two programs for people with mental illness and other disabilities in Anoka and Hennepin counties—Parkway House and Girard House—and a case management service in Ramsey County.

WE ADDED a staff psychiatrist to provide psychiatric services to clients in multiple programs and to provide tele-video services to clients living in rural Minnesota.

WE TRAINED AND PROVIDED consultation to 15 provider agencies on illness management and recovery under a grant from the Minnesota Department of Human Services, and to 14 agencies on topics such as de-escalation, motivational interviewing, and boundaries and ethics.

WE ADDED a volunteer coordinator to develop and expand our volunteer connections and opportunities.

WE MAINTAINED funding for our homeless services Safe Havens programs—working with the legislature and the governor's office—and obtained continuation funding for our Ramsey County homeless outreach services.

WE RAISED \$40,276 through our house-to-home event in October to purchase sofas, dining tables, beds, chairs, and other furnishings to help make our residential homes comfortable and hope-inspiring.

WE RAISED \$578,777 from 1,030 individuals and foundations during our annual campaign.

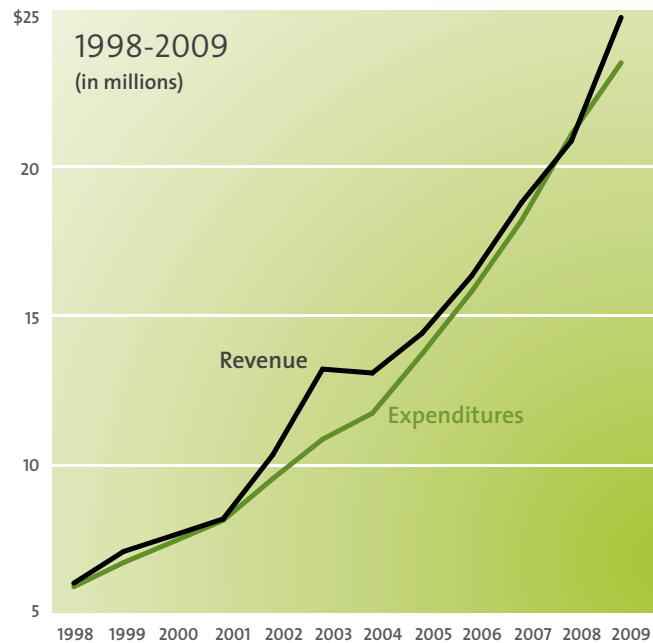

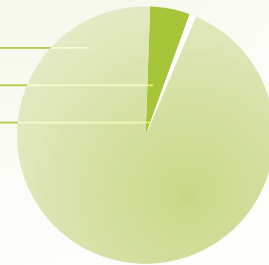
FINANCIAL REPORT 2009

REVENUE & EXPENDITURES



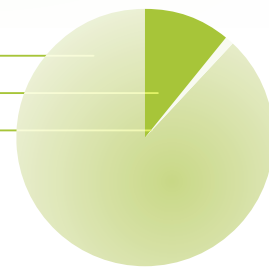
Revenue 2009

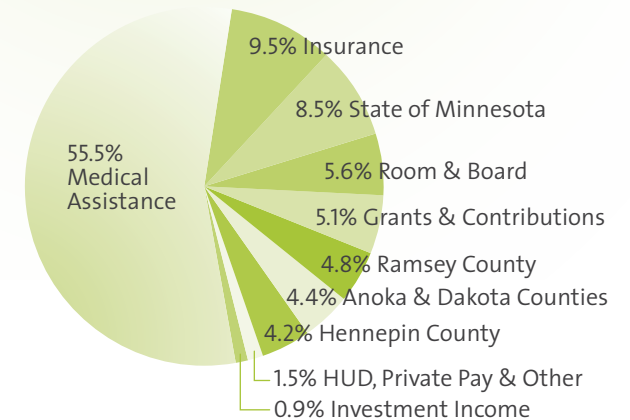
