THANK YOU, VOLUNTEERS!

Spring marked the annual return of our tremendous roster of gardening and landscaping volunteers. PROMOTING UNDERSTANDING

CHANGING MINDS

These recognitions included Provider of the Year from NAMI Minnesota, a Local Government Innovation Award from the UofM Humphrey School of Public Affairs and a Commissioner's Circle of Excellence Award from the Minnesota Department of Human Services.

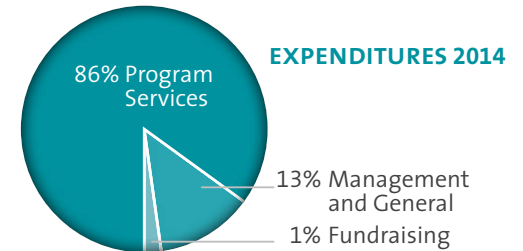
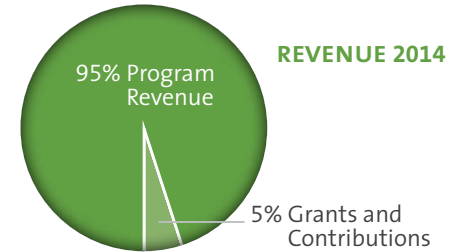
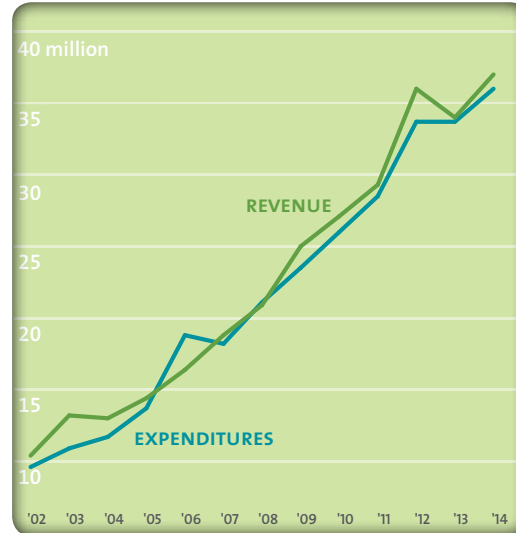
INCORPORATING EFFICIENCY

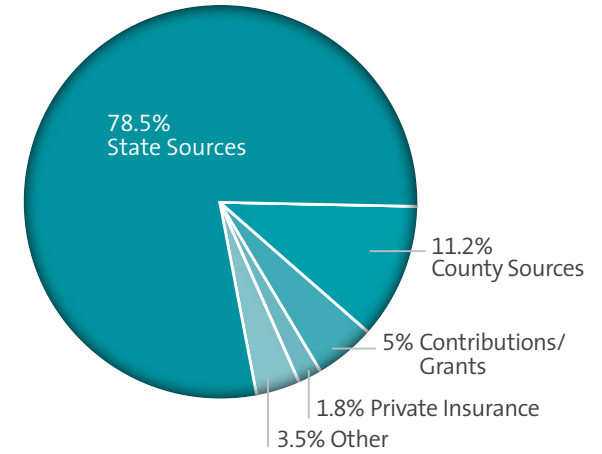
REVENUE & EXPENDITURES 2002-2014



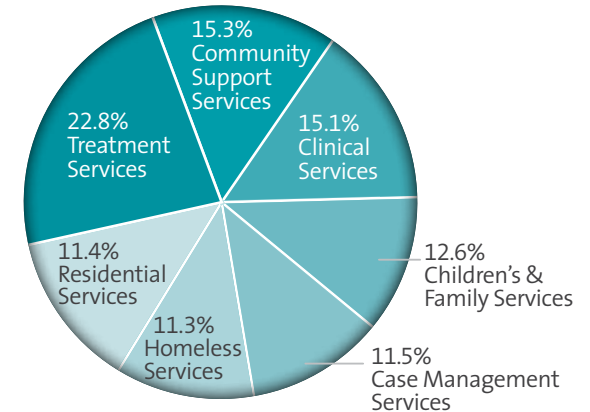

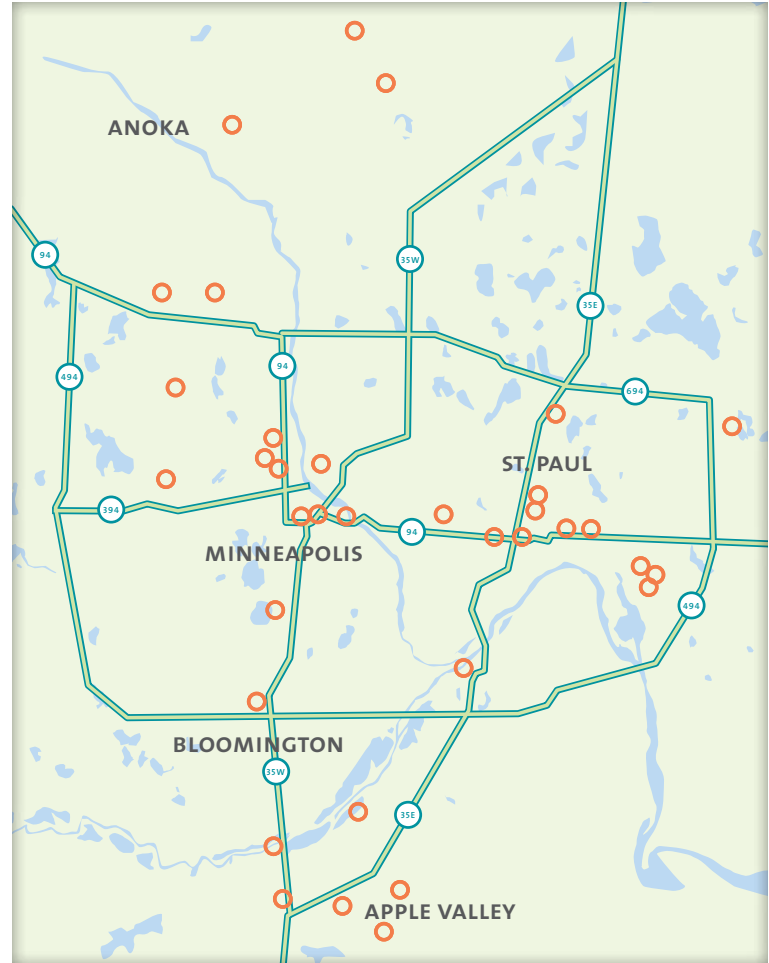
