Targeted Case Management for Children

Children's targeted case management helps individuals under 18 years of age gain access to medical, social, educational, vocational and other necessary services connected to the person's mental health needs. Eligible children must have a mental health diagnosis.



Who We Serve

- › Children age 5-17 at the start of services and their caregivers
- › Children served are struggling with functioning at home, in school or in the community due to a serious mental health diagnosis



Our Services

Case management services are coordinated services designed to help the child and their family obtain appropriate support, including mental and physical health services, social and educational services, vocational and recreational services, and other related support such as volunteer services, advocacy, transportation, and legal services.
