## Program Offerings

We operate various programs, including:

- Crisis and intensive residential treatment services (IRTS) for adults
- Outreach to homeless individuals in need
- Case management services
- Outpatient mental health services for adults, children, & families
- Integrated care within jails and community for adults
- Mental health services within schools for children

## Program Values

- Create an Integrated System of Care: a "one-stop" integrated model for mental health care, allowing us to meet clients anywhere they need to be seen.
- Person-Centered Care: helping people with mental illness requires flexibility and creativity, so we start with the person first, allowing the patient to seize initiative in their own continuum of care.



## Program Impact

- Our Homeless Outreach team reaches over 2,500 individuals and families
- Outpatient mental health clinics in St. Paul, Minneapolis, New Hope, & Coon Rapids serve over 5,000 patients
- School-Linked mental health services reach over 500 children in 25 schools & 4 districts
- Over 1,800 individuals receive crisis stabilization and mental health care
- Artability provides art & music therapy to nearly 1,000 in-person and over 200 virtual participants
